Extensive Set-Up
Should your entrance, performance, exit and prop set up exceed your entry time limit, please include this on your online registration. You will be charged \$100 for an extra time slot.

Pre-Season Showcase OnlyCRITIQUE ONLY: Teams may perform any team routines for critique only.

Classic HS Teams will be combined into ONE classification and Select HS Teams will be combined into ONE classification regardless of team size for both officer and team routines.

They will be eligible for all of the officer and team awards with the exception of Overall Showcase awards.

Virtual or Destination Showcase Only CRITIQUE ONLY: Teams may perform any team routines for critique only.

Directors Only

Each Director will be given a name badge. Names must be indicated in the registration system.

PARTICIPANT & SPECATOR RELEASE

All participants and spectators must acknowledge the hold harmless agreement posted at the spectator and team entrance.

VIDEOGRAPHY / PHOTOGRAPHY

Personal videography and photography will be permitted. However, no electrical outlets will be available for personal use and tripods/monopods are strictly prohibited.

Tablets larger than 10" may only be used on the back row.

Flash photography is strictly prohibited in ALL performance areas.



DRESSING ROOMS

The host school will assign dressing rooms the morning of contest at check-in.

As a general rule, men or male directors will not be permitted in the female dressing room area.

If you have male team members, please add a note to your online registration and we will help coordinate special dressing room arrangements.

CP will not be responsible for providing any chaperones for your dressing room area. Please make arrangements to best suit your team's needs.

PROPS, CURTAINS AND PERFORMANCE FLOOR

Because a limited time is allotted for each team routine (including entrance, set up, tear down and exit) only minimal set up is allowed on the floor. Any exceptions must be submitted during the online registration process to be paid and scheduled accordingly. See Extensive Set Up policy above. (P.16)

Props

For props that shed (poms, confetti, streamers, flowers) please have a team representative scheduled to clean the floor following the performance.

The use of glitter, water, powder, pyrotechnics and/or facility electrical outlets is strictly prohibited.

Curtains

Curtains, staging, and other props should be constructed to fit through a 7 foot tall double door with the center support bar removed.

Curtains may be provided at some CP locations. See website for curtain specification and details.

Performance Floor

Please be sure to pad (foam, felt, tape) the bottom of all wooden/metal props. You will be responsible for any damage to the gym floor due to improperly padded props or other negligence. Directors you will be asked to sign a contract acknowledging and agreeing to the Host School facility property damage policies.

You may not tap or clog directly on gym floor. You will be responsible for providing padded tap boards/flooring. Other facility options may not be available.

MUSIC

All music must be uploaded via the online registration portal 2 weeks prior to the event. For your convenience, your uploaded music will be played in the practice area.

Please bring a digital copy of your music (IPod or IPad) for back up. Please plan to have a representative at the music table to operate your device to avoid any confusion.

Upon registering, you will notice you are required to check a box verifying that all of the music you are using at the event has been purchased legally and has not been altered in any way that violates any copyright laws. Furthermore, you will be asked to certify that you hold harmless Crowd Pleasers Dance from being liable if your music violates any copyright laws.



VIRTUAL SHOWCASE GUIDELINES

If less than 15 HS Teams are registered, Classic HS Teams will be combined into ONE classification and Select HS Teams will be combined into ONE classification regardless of team size for both officer and team routines.

There must be 50 total entires for the virtual event to take place.

See general rules and regulations for entry time limits classifications and awards.

Upload your video through your CP registration dashboard.

The final deadline to upload your video is 2 weeks prior to the published LIVE STREAM event date.

VIDEO GUIDELINES & RECOMMENDATIONS

Be sure to frame the entire performance from the judge's perspective.

(On center and if possible, at an elevated angle.)

Team and Officer routines must be recorded in a gymnasium with standard gymnasium lighting.

Avoid excessive negative space.

Solos and ensembles routines may require some zooming to capture the performance.

Always include all of the active dancers. Team and officer routines should include the entire performance floor to capture all of the parts and visuals.

Costumes are not required, but a professional performance ready appearance recommended.

The upload video format must be .mp4 and uploaded to your account. (YouTube or Google links will NOT be accepted.)

Our experienced panel of judges will meet to evaluate.
Our general CP rules and regulations will be followed for feedback, scoring and awards. Classifications may be adjusted based on overall contest size.

The entire contest will be live streamed on the published event day. The contest will be streamed in order of the published schedule.

The Awards Ceremony.

Immediately following the last performance, the awards ceremony will begin. Awards will be shipped to your preferred location.

Receive your feedback.

Immediately following the awards ceremony, critiques will be accessible via your CP registration dashboard. Each routine will receive 3 videos and 3 score sheets. (One per judge.)


