#### **DEDUCTIONS**

In an effort to promote a wholesome contest environment that can be enjoyed by family members of all ages, CP will support its judges in the deduction of points for inappropriate music, costuming, or movement. Please note that these deductions may affect your final standings for all categories. These point deductions will be clearly indicated in the box on the bottom of each score sheet.

#### **EXTENSIVE SET-UP**

Should your entrance, performance, exit and prop set up exceed your entry time limit, please include this on your online registration. You will be charged \$100 for an extra time slot. (4.5 Min.)

#### **PRE-SEASON SHOWCASE ONLY**

CRITIQUE ONLY: Teams may perform any team routines for critique only.

Classic HS Teams will be combined into ONE classification and Select HS Teams will be combined into ONE classification regardless of team size for both officer and team routines.

They will be eligible for all of the officer and team awards with the exception of Overall Showcase awards.

#### VIRTUAL OR DESTINATION SHOWCASE ONLY
