CANDIDATE REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be a High School Graduate or will be as of June 2026
- Must have held the position of a Dance/Social Officer on a High School Dance/Drill team.
 - *exceptions on a case by case basis*
- Must reside within or the surrounding ares of Austin/San Antonio, Dallas/Fort Worth or Houston.
- Must submit PHASE ONE items by November 1st, 2025 to be considered for a staff position.
 - Upon invitation to PHASE TWO, all items must be submitted by December 15th, 2025.
- Must be available for an online Interview January 15th-February 15th, if contacted by Crowd Pleasers for the final selection phase.
- Must be available for Staff Training in Houston (staff lodging provided)
 - May 15 17, 2026
- Must be available to work during Officer Camp Week:
 - May 26 June 2, 2026.
- Must be available to work 4 out of the 5 following critical weeks of summer season:
 - July 6 10, 2026
 - July 13 17, 2026
 - July 20 24, 2026
 - July 27 31, 2026
 - August 3 7, 2026

- Solo Video Please upload a video of a solo performance from last competition season.
